

## AFFILIATE QUALIFYING FOR AQHA/AJQHA WORLD SHOWS

BCQHA \_\_\_\_\_

AQHA/AJQHA determines the qualifications necessary for individuals and/or their horses to compete at major/world championships. These are set out each year and usually require a number of competition points at AQHA approved shows to be able to compete. Sometimes an alternate route is provided for affiliates to qualify individuals who may not have met these points.

For qualification under this provision the member requesting to qualify must be a BCQHA member (both qualifying and show years). No exceptions will be made to this requirement.

Members must submit the request in writing in sufficient time for the affiliate to meet AQHA deadlines for having names in.

Members must show in at least four BCQHA shows or have been BCQHA Hi Point or reserve class winners for the previous year in the classes they are requesting. Show dates, classes and placings during the qualifying period must be attached to the request.

If a class is not offered in a show in BC, then the requestor must include a show record of competitions in sanctioned events to demonstrate they are competitive at the world level.

All requests are to be sent to the BCQHA Secretary by mail or e-mail. Verbal requests will not be accepted.

If more applications are received than permitted spots then the BCQHA Board will have the sole right to decide who will be given spaces.
